Week Ending April 4, 2008**

***Monterey Shores Moratorium Update***

Carolina Water has received all permits from the NC Division of Water Quality and is moving forward on the expansion of the wastewater treatment plant that serves Monterey Shores and Corolla Bay. The good news is that Carolina Water has decided to have all the capacity come online at once – instead of being allocated in phases. This scenario was the cause of concern for many that attended a meeting last year in Corolla. Who was going to be “first” in line and how that was going to be determined raised some eyebrows. Having all capacity come online at one time eliminates those fears. The date of completion, however, has been moved back a couple of months to May 2009.

Those in Corolla will notice that work is being done in Corolla Bay. Developers have been issued state and county permits for dry line installation for wastewater; the system can't be used until the plant is open. This allows them to complete the work on the subdivision's infrastructure (roads, etc.) and build a model home without having “open” access to wastewater treatment.
